2011 SCHOOL TERMS.

The usual length of each school term has been adjusted for 2011.

Terms 1 and 2 are slightly longer than usual and Term 4 is two weeks shorter. This adjustment has been made to align the October term holiday with the final stages of the 2011 Rugby World Cup.

Term One will start between Monday 31 January (at the earliest) and Monday 7 February (at the latest) until Friday April 15. The date is yet to be confirmed by the Board of Trustees.

Term Two: Monday May 2 to Friday 15 July.

Term Three: Monday August 1 to Friday October 7. (Note: Hawkes Bay Anniversary Day is Friday October 31 and is in the school holidays).

Term 4: Tuesday October 25, to no later than Tuesday 20 December.

The school has to be open for 390 half days in 2011.
