Dear Parents

As you are aware, it is a tradition at Napier Central School for Year 6 children to present a speech in assembly. In 2012, Room 6 will be presenting during Term 1, so I would appreciate it if you could spend some time over the next 2 weeks helping your child to draft their speech.

Your child may talk about one of the following:

- something they are interested in or passionate about e.g. a sport, hobby,
- an achievement,
- an experience e.g. a trip.

They should use some sort of visual aid to enhance their speech e.g. a prop, a costume, a demonstration or a Power point. It should last for no longer than 3 minutes. Try to encourage your child to make their presentation fun, interesting and unique!

I will make sure that all Year 6 children have plenty of time to practise at school with a microphone in front of the class prior to their assembly presentation. Assemblies will be on alternative Monday's starting at 2.15pm.
